Beaumont Health closes deal to merge 3 nonprofit systems

New organization names 14 to board

Three months after announcing a definitive agreement to merge operations into a single health system – **Beaumont Health** – officials for the new eight-hospital nonprofit system said today that they closed the deal.

Officials recently received federal antitrust and tax-exempt status approval to move forward with the new organization. Michigan Attorney General Bill Schuette last week said he had no objections to the \$3.8 billion merger.

"This is a great day for the people of Southeastern Michigan," said John Lewis, chairman of Beaumont Health, in the statement. "Beaumont Health will continue the traditions of our legacy organizations as a nonprofit, locally governed organization. With our combined strengths of patient satisfaction, medical excellence and community focus, we look forward to serving the health needs of patients and families for years to come, with quality and compassion guiding all that we do."

Beaumont Health officials released little information on the new organization other than to name the new 14-member board. It is representative of the three organizations: **Beaumont Health System, Oakwood Healthcare Inc.** and **Botsford Health Care**.

Beaumont officials listed several decisions to be made this year. They include appointing a new Beaumont Health executive team, determining a corporate headquarters (temporary location in Troy), developing a corporate structure and integrating hospital names within the new system.

Beaumont Health consists of eight hospitals with 3,337 beds, 153 outpatient sites, 5,000 physicians, more than 33,000 employees and about 3,500 volunteers, it said in a release. In 2013, the combined organizations had 168,047 inpatient admissions, 15,997 births and 492,677 emergency visits, it said.
